# Iron Maiden

Believe it or not, another release from Iron Maiden hammers down our doors. Less than two years after the release of their latest album, *A Matter of Life and Death*, a greatest hits CD has been unleashed to coincide with their *Somewhere Back in Time World Tour*. In an unprecedented move, Iron Maiden has made the album available for free download from their official website. The catch is that you can only play it three times, and then must either delete or purchase it, and the tracks are not compatible with Macs or iPods since they are protected in WMA (Windows Media Audio) format.

The album contains greatest hits from Iron Maiden's first seven albums, and has received positive reviews from mainstream metal magazines such as *Kerrang* and *Metal Hammer*.

*Somewhere Back in Time* does not really bring anything new to the table, and might not be too valuable for the true Iron Maiden fan who is familiar with all Iron Maiden albums — as countless as they are. However, for all others who want to get a glimpse at the chaotic universe of Maiden metal, and listen to songs from the time when mummies and ancient Egyptians were — and still are, judging from this album — enough of rock stars to appear on metal album covers, *Somewhere Back in Time - The Best of: 1980-1989* is definitely worth your time, and should you really like it, your money.
